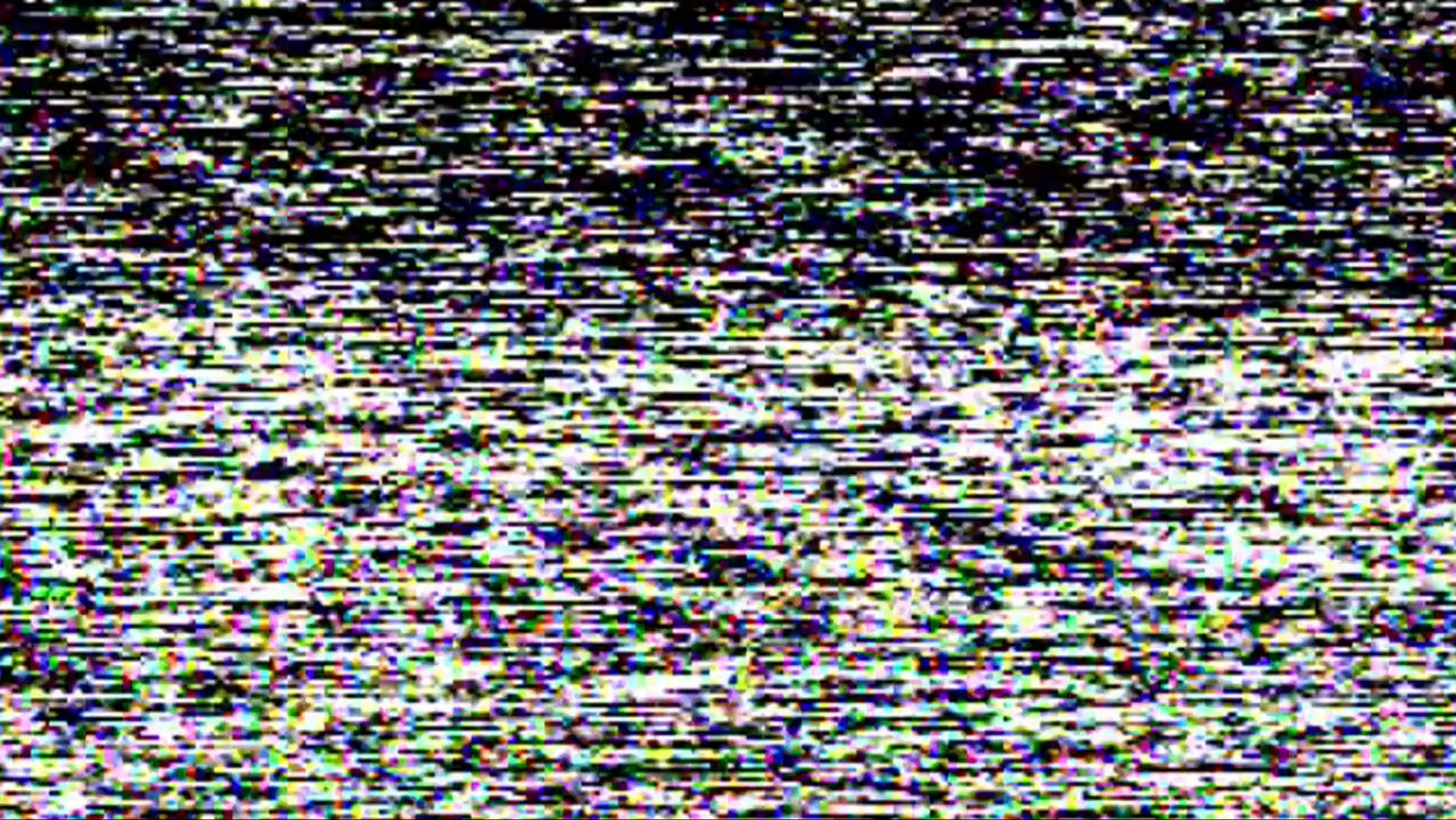

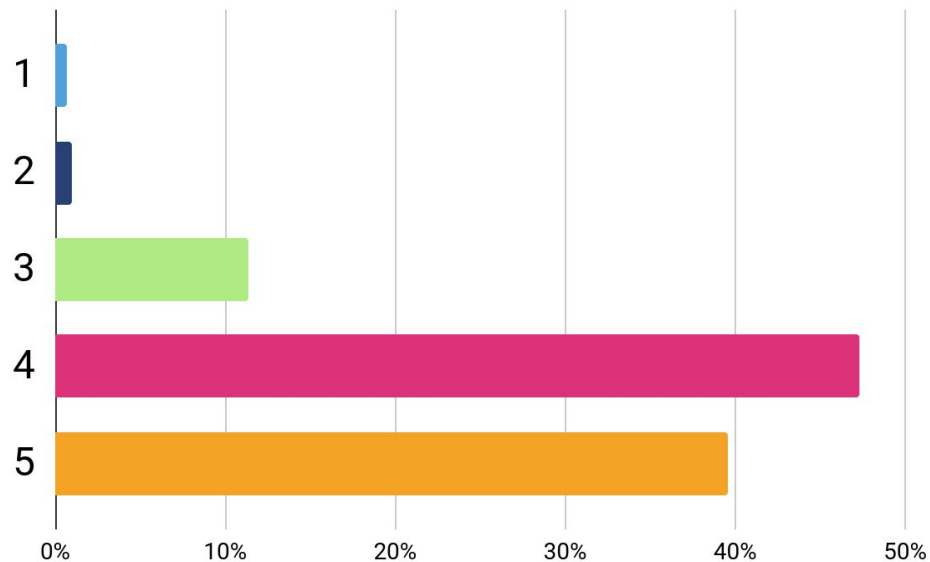

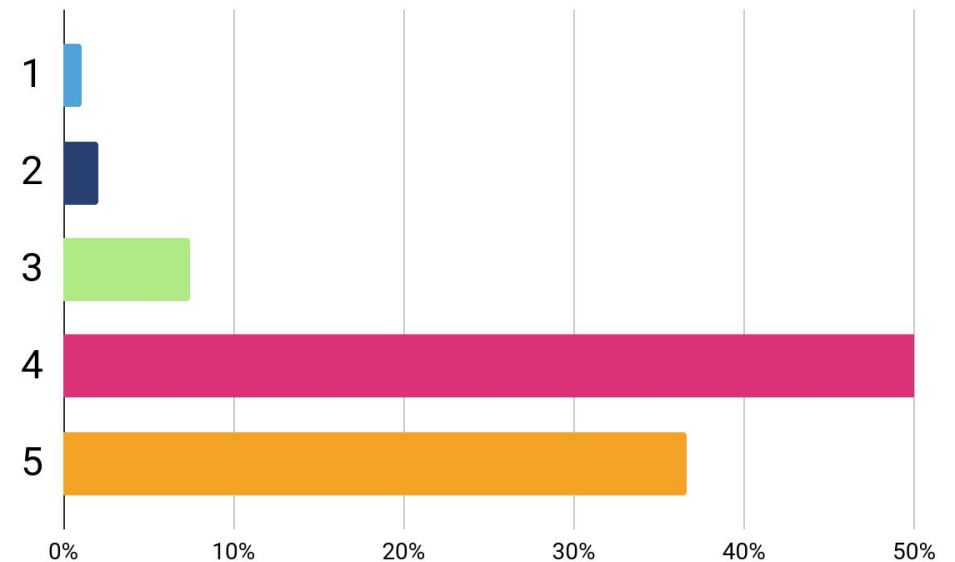


How satisfied are you with the Fedora Project Overall? (2021)

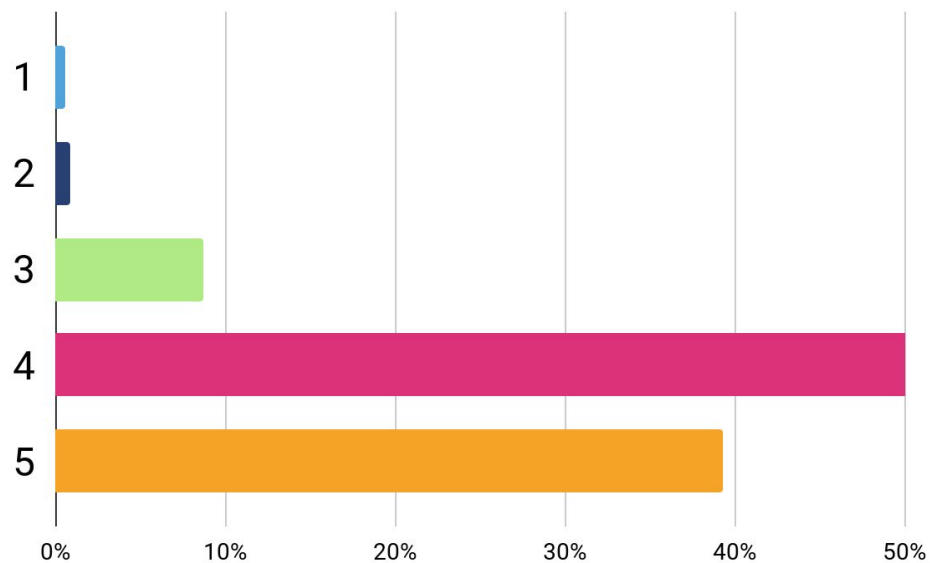

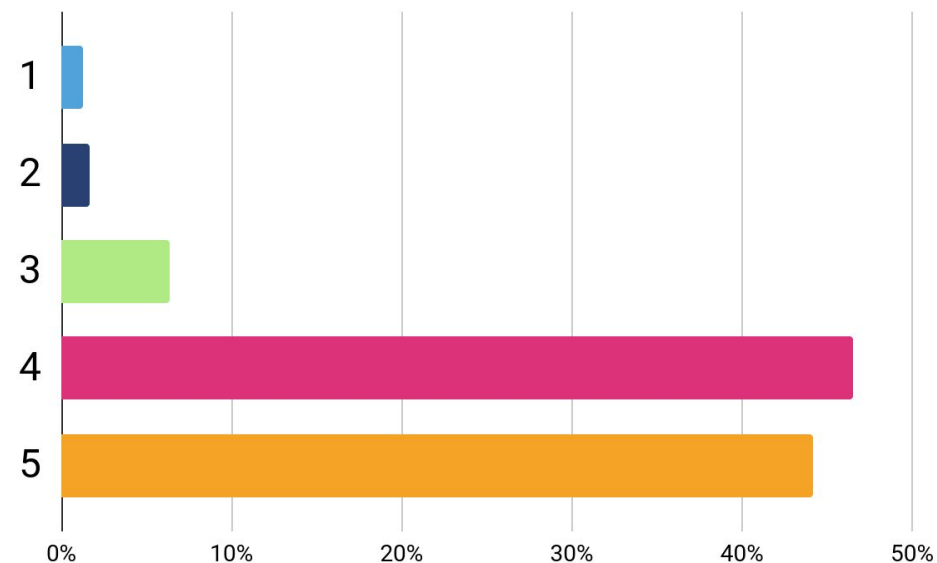


How satisfied are you with the Fedora Project Overall? (2022)

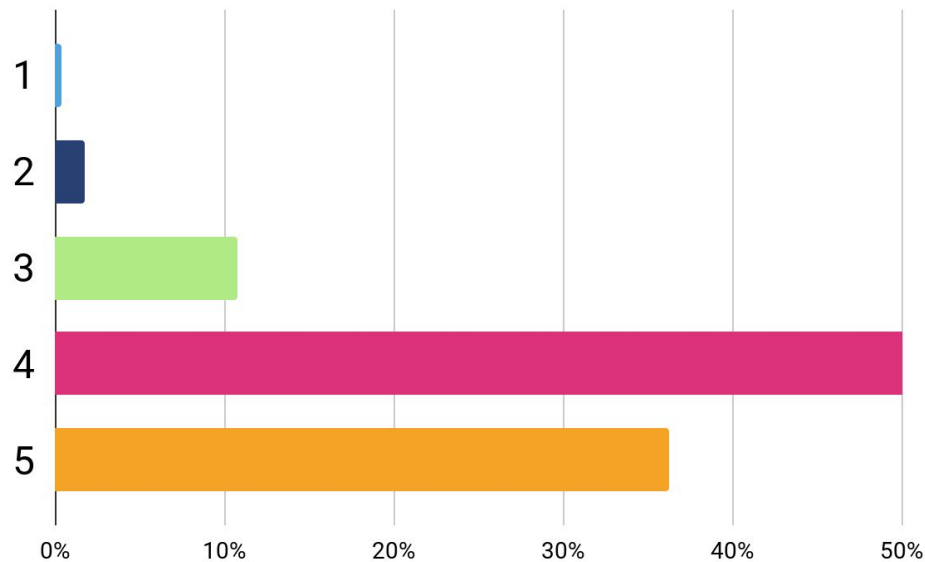

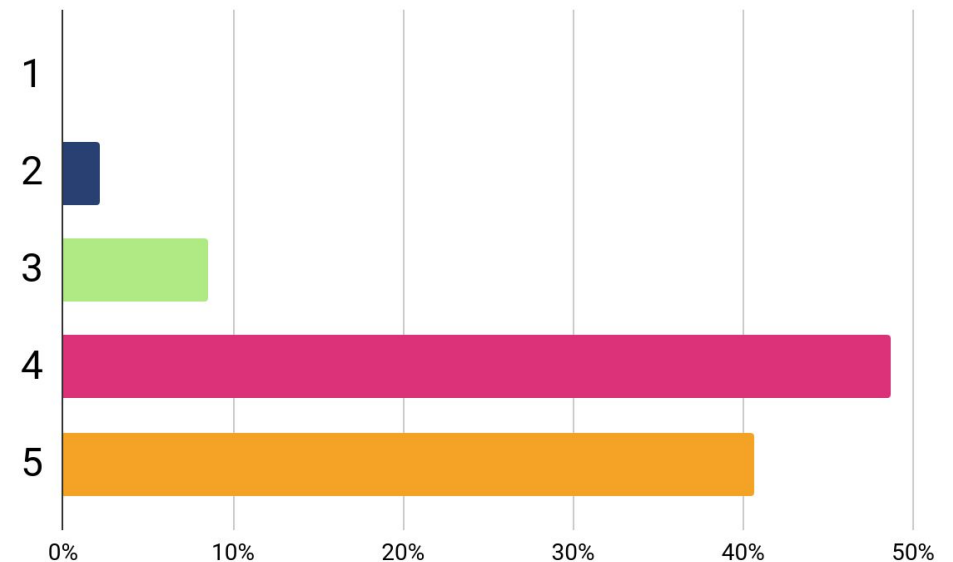


How satisfied are you with the Fedora Project Overall? (This year)

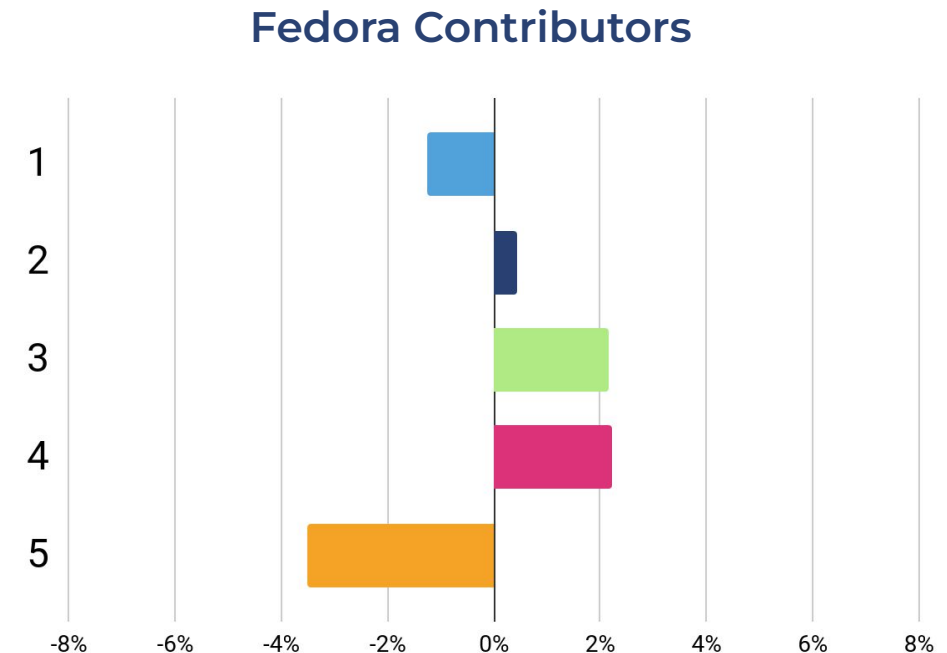
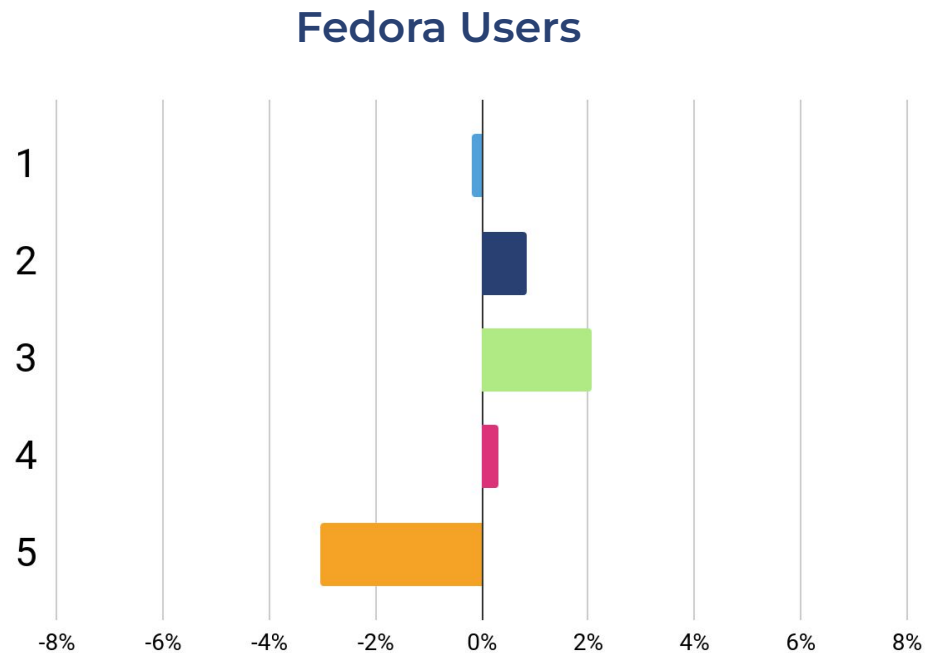

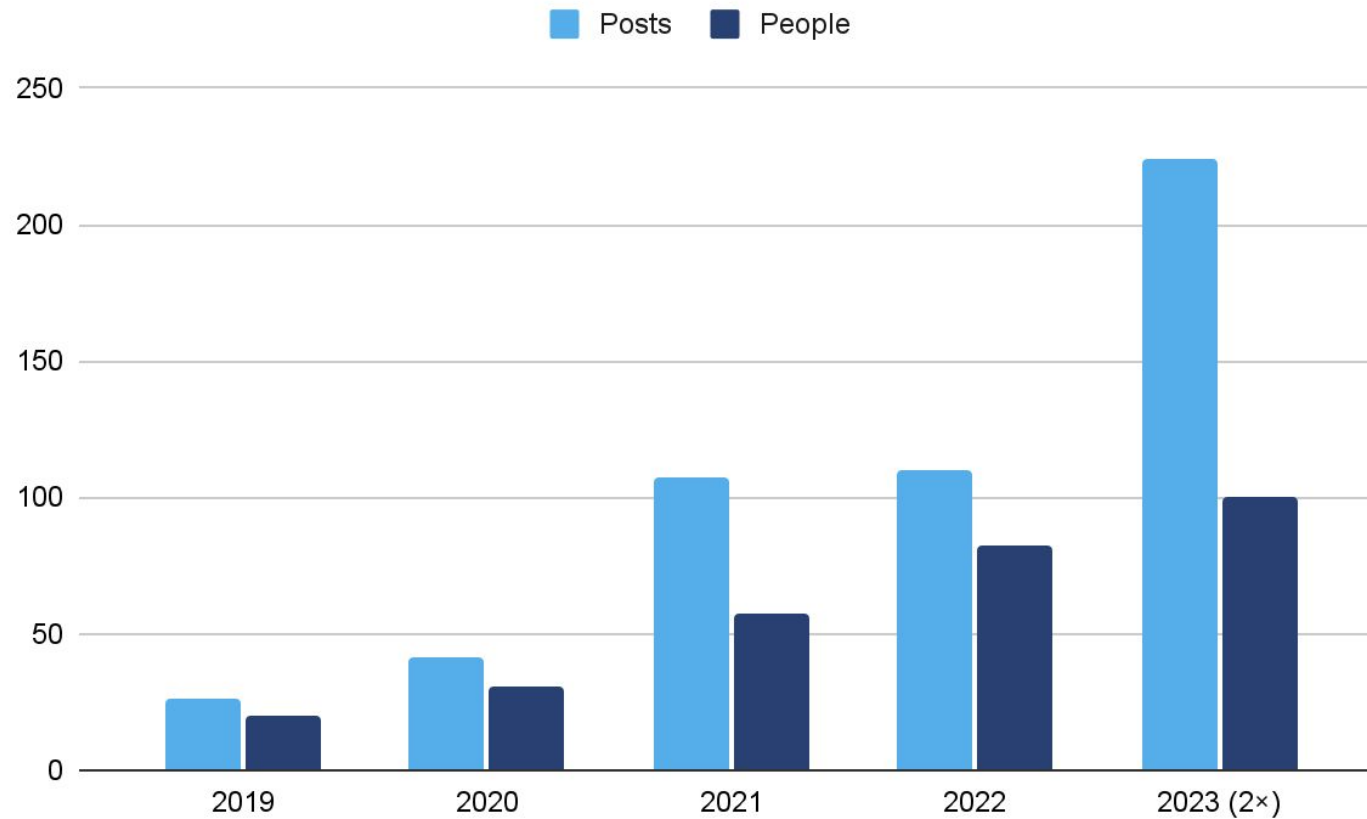

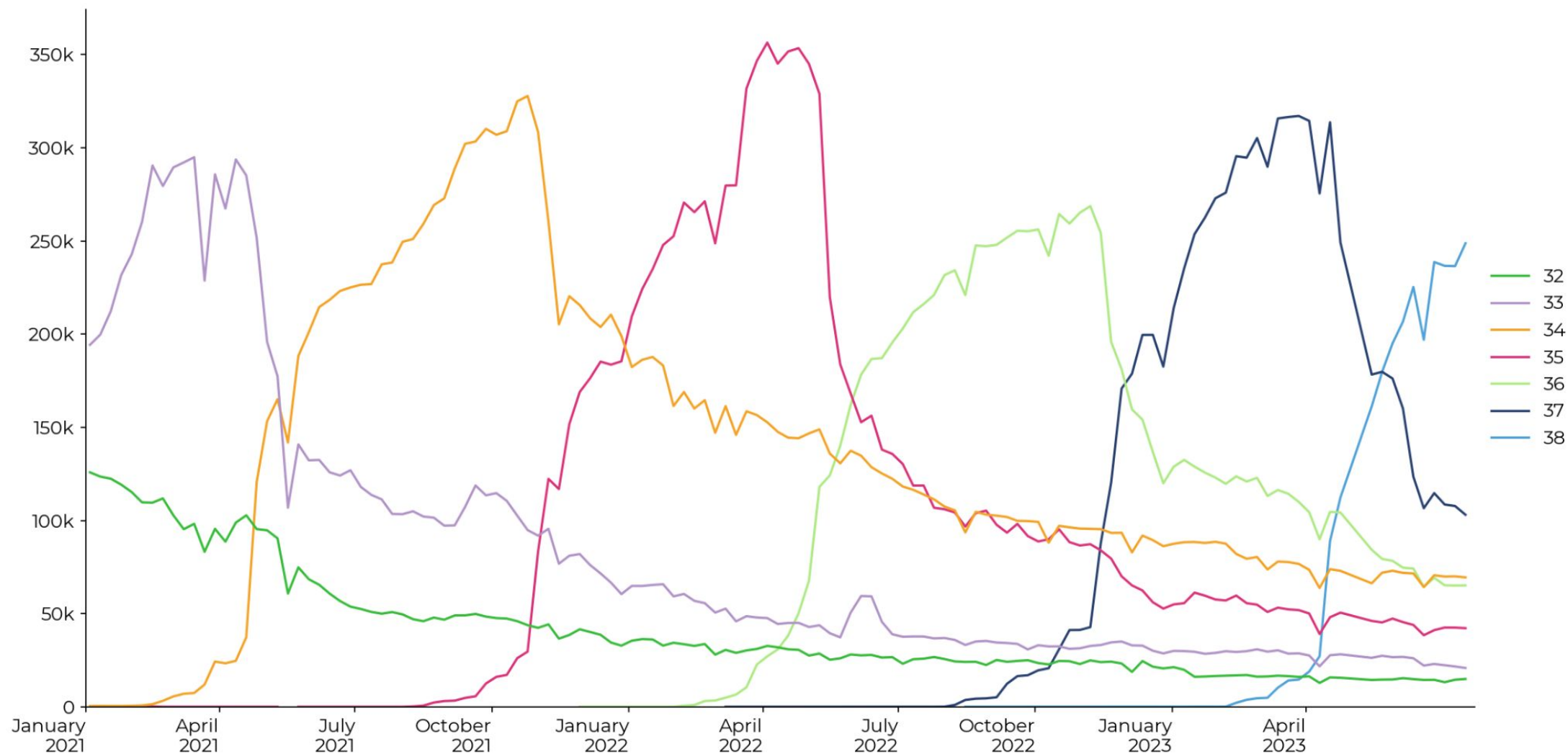

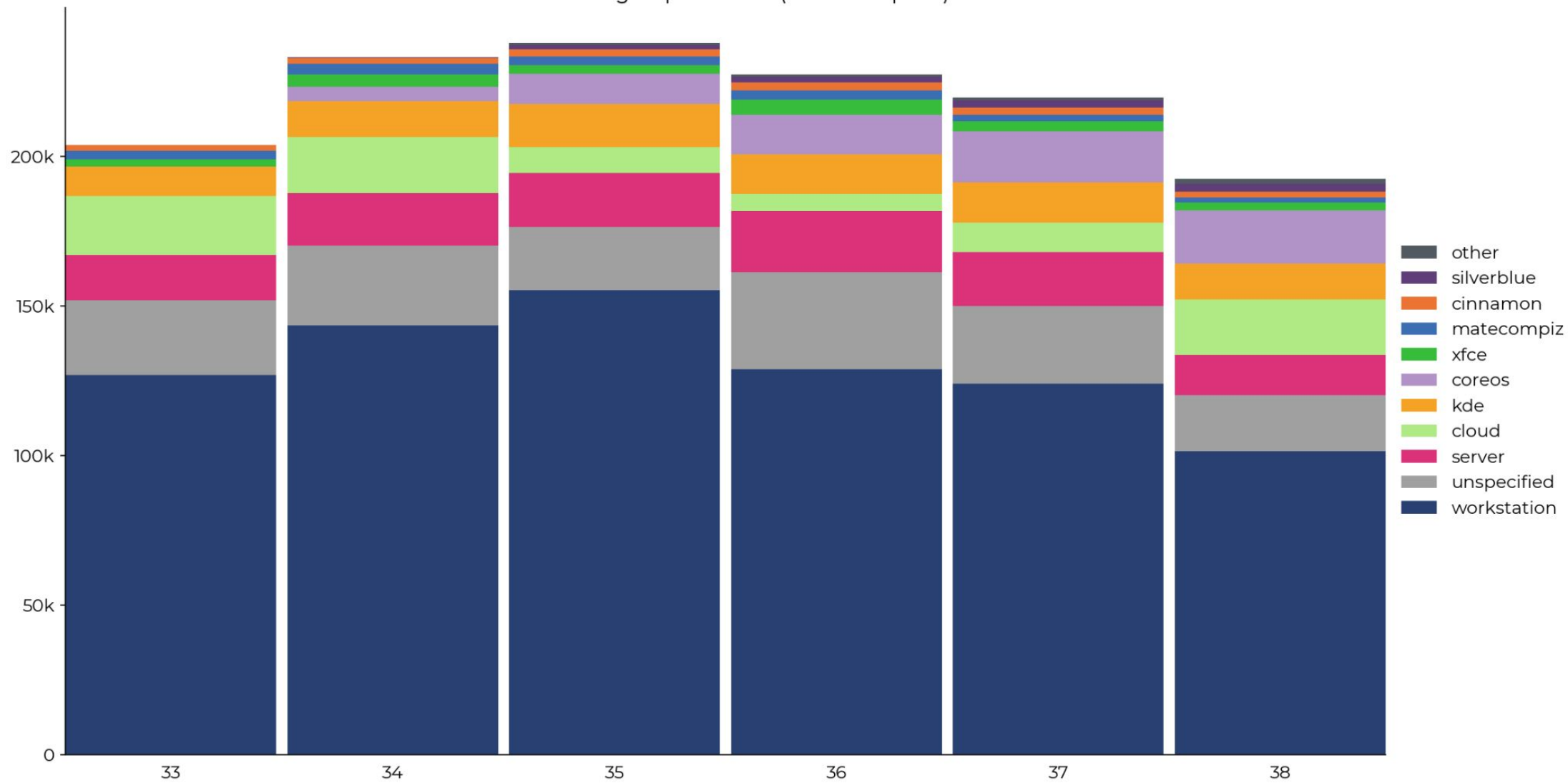


Fedora Linux systems: release weekly checkins



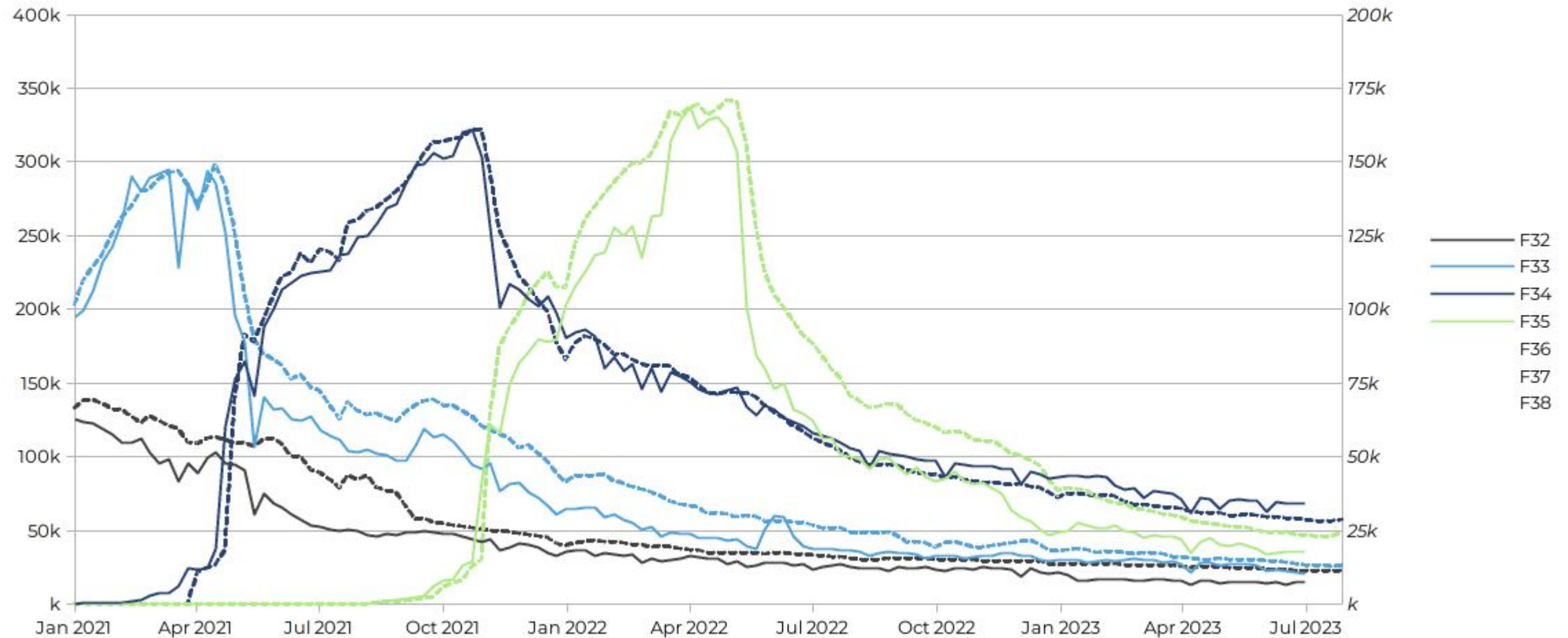
Fedora Linux systems: variant by release

Included: age = persistent (at release peak)



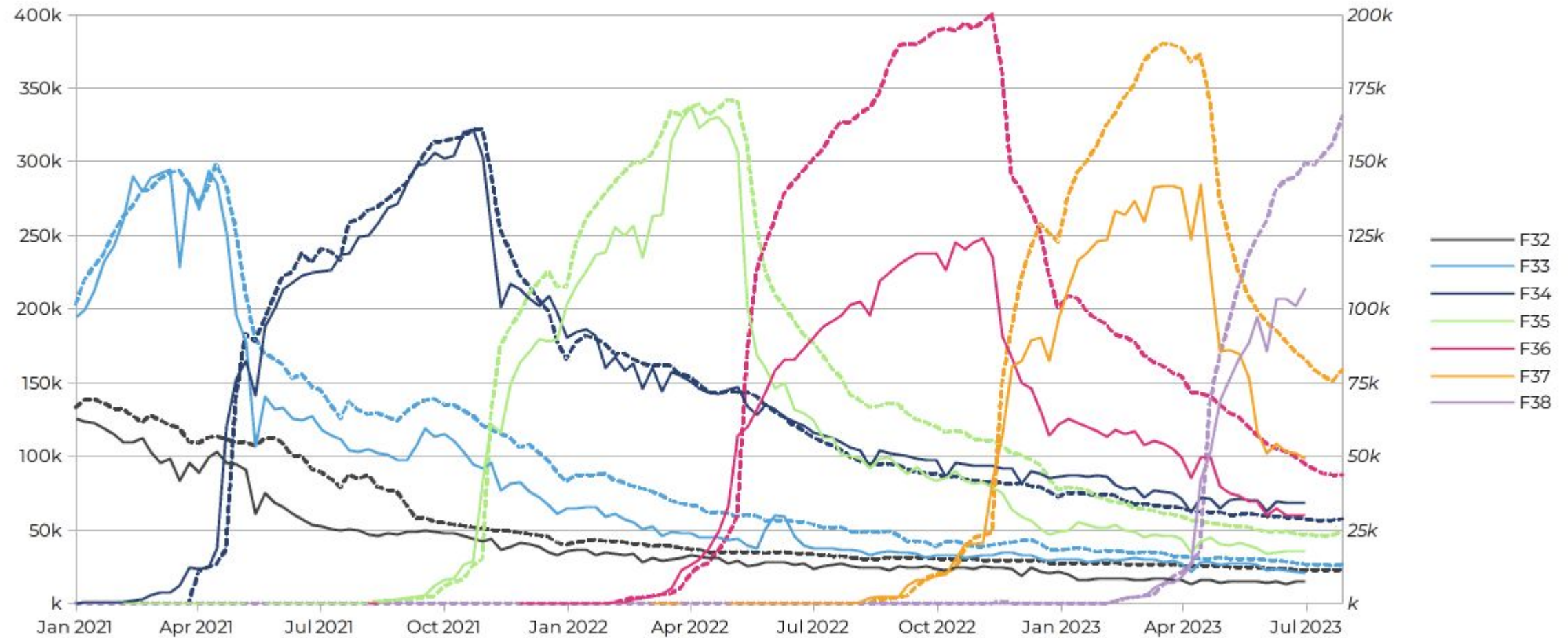
Matching with the old counting method
